

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Monday August 23, 2010 at 6:00P.M.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

The Common Council of the City of Crawfordsville, Indiana, met in Committee, 6:00 PM., August 23, 2010. Present were Mayor Charles Coons, City Attorney David Peebles and Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd. Also present were Council members Nellie Thompson who chaired the meeting, Heather Perkins, George Parker, Roger Rockenbaugh, Patrick Taylor, Dennis Cook and Raymond Kirtley.

The first item presented was a presentation on Local Option Income Tax by Darrin Bates of Data Pits.

Roger Rockenbaugh Chairman of the Fiscal Affairs Committee presented the second item, a resolution authorizing a sidewalk grant for Dick & Betty Munro. Chairman Rockenbaugh moved to send the resolution to the full Council with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Councilwoman Thompson. A voice vote was unanimous to move this resolution to the full Council with a favorable recommendation.

Nellie Thompson Chairwoman of the Ordinances and Petitions Committee presented the third item, an ordinance amending regulating the collection of municipal waste and setting fees and rates for municipal waste collection. Chairwoman Thompson moved to send the ordinance onto the full Council with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Councilman Cook. A voice vote was unanimous to move the ordinance to the full Council on September 20, 2010 with a favorable recommendation.

Chairwoman Nellie Thompson concluded the Committee of the Whole at 8:45PM.

SPECIAL COUNIL MEETING

The Common Council of the City of Crawfordsville, Indiana, met in a special session, 8:55 PM., August 23, 2010. Present were Mayor Charles Coons, who chaired the meeting. City Attorney David Peebles and Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd. Also present were Council members Nellie Thompson, Heather Perkins, George Parker, Roger Rockenbaugh, Patrick Taylor, Dennis Cook and Raymond Kirtley.

Other officials in attendance were Plan Department Director Brandy Allen, Street Commissioner Scott Hesler, Wastewater Director Tom Mitchell, Storm Water Director Gary Weliver, Park and Recreation Director Roger Neal, Assistant Police Chief Mike Norman and Fire Chief Eric Small.

The Press was also present.

Chairman Coons called the meeting to order. Councilman Taylor led the pledge to the flag.

Councilman Rockenbaugh said the prayer.

Chairman Coons asked Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd to call the roll for the purpose of attendance all Council members were present.

The roll was called for the purpose of any additions to the agenda. Councilman Cook had one addition.

Chairman Coons called on Councilman Rockenbaugh to present the business of the Fiscal Affairs committee.

FISCAL AFFAIRS

The first item presented was the resolution authorizing a sidewalk grant for Dick & Betty Munro. Chairman Rockenbaugh moved to approve the resolution. Seconded by Councilman Parker. Chairman Coons called for comments from the Council and public. Hearing none Chairman Coons called for the vote. The resolution was passed with a unanimous vote.

RESOLUTION 22-2010

The second item presented was the second reading of an ordinance adopting a new schedule of rates and charges for services rendered by Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power. Chairman Rockenbaugh moved place the ordinance on second reading. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Chairman Coons called for comments from the Council and public. Offering comments were Phil Goode of CEL&P, Ron Gable of CEL&P, Bob Clifford of Umbaugh, and Mike Craycraft. Also offering comments were Council members Perkins, Cook, Parker, Taylor and David Peebles City Attorney Hearing no further comments Chairman Coons called for the vote. The ordinance was passed on second reading with a six to one vote. Councilwoman Perkins voting nay.

SECOND READING

Chairman Rockenbaugh moved to place the ordinance on third and final reading and so adopt. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Chairman Coons called for comments from the Council and public. Hearing none Chairman Coons called for the vote. The ordinance was passed on third and final reading with a six to one vote. Councilwoman Perkins voting nay.

Chairman Coons called on Councilman Cook.
