

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE CITY OF CRAWFORDSVILLE

On or about May 29, 2009, the City of Crawfordsville intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for reimbursement from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs' CDBG Disaster Recovery Appropriation #1. This program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. These funds are to be used for community disaster assistance. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$ 26,930.83. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and moderate-income persons is \$ 12,468.97.

The City of Crawfordsville will hold a public hearing on May 20, 2009, at 10:00 A.M. (Local Time) at the Crawfordsville City Hall, Council Chambers (300 East Pike Street) to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG Disaster Recovery reimbursement. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Brenda Tarter, Executive Assistant, at 765-364-5160, not later than May 18, 2009. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

Information related to this CDBG reimbursement application will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of May 18, 2009, at the City Hall, between the hours of 9:00 A.M - 4:30 P.M.. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding the proposed federal reimbursement at the public hearing or provide a written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Brenda Tarter, Executive Assistant, no later than May 20, 2009, in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Crawfordsville and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement.
