

RULES OF THE TRAIL

- Trail open daylight hours only
- Motorized vehicles prohibited
- Place litter in receptacles
- Keep pets leashed and pick up after them
- Stay to the right of the trail
- Pass on the left giving audible signals
- Stop, look and listen at road intersections
- Stay on the trail and be respectful of adjacent property owners
- Helmets recommended for cyclists and skaters

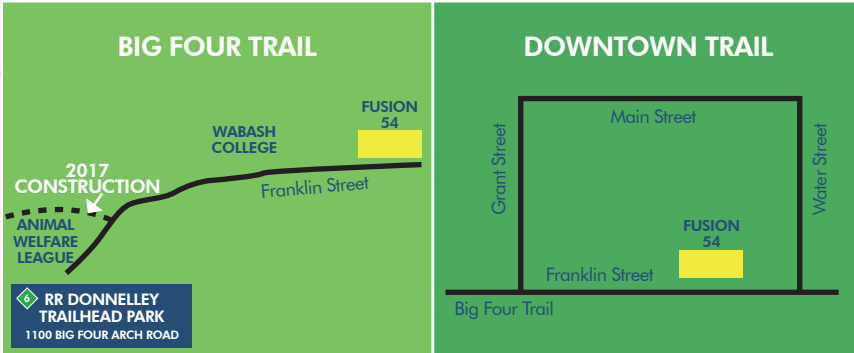
MILEAGE
