

Crawfordsville Common Council Meeting

Monday, January 9, 2017

Minutes

The Crawfordsville Common Council met in regular session on Monday, January 9, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd, City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman – Les Hearson, Councilman – Charlie Warren, Councilman - Scott Molin, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Andy Biddle and Councilman – Mike Reidy. 
Adjournment
