

# Crawfordsville Common Council Meeting

Monday, March 13, 2017

## Minutes

The Crawfordsville Common Council met in regular session on Monday, March 13, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd, City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman – Les Hearson, Councilman – Charlie Warren, Councilman – Dan Guard, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman - Scott Molin, Councilman – Andy Biddle and Councilman – Mike Reidy.

Also present were: Scott Hesler – Street Department, Mike Norman – Police Department, Scott Busenbark – Fire Department, Phil Goode – CEL&P, Brandy Allen – Planning Department, Fawn Johnson – Park & Recreation and Larry Kadinger – Waste Water Department.

Councilman Guard led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Molin led the prayer.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. All Council members were present.

Councilman Hearson moved to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2017 meeting. Councilman Biddle seconded. Motion passed.

Councilman Molin moved to acknowledge receipt of the monthly financials. Councilman Reidy seconded. Motion passed.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. No additions were requested.

## Public Hearing

Mayor Barton opened the public hearing on an additional appropriation for the 2017 budget for the Parks and Recreation/Golf Course Management Fees at 7:03pm. Hearing no comments the hearing was closed at 7:03pm.

## Fiscal Affairs

First item presented was an Ordinance Liquidating and Dissolving the SAFER Firefighter Retention Fund, a Dormant Fund, and Amending the Ambulance and Major Rescue Equipment Replacement Fund under City Code Section 35.29. Councilman Biddle moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Hearson seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

## (First Reading)

Second item presented was An Ordinance Amending the Sidewalk Maintenance and Improvement Non-Reverting Fund. Councilman Biddle moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Reidy seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Reidy and Mayor Barton offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

The third item presented was a second reading of an Ordinance Making an Additional Appropriation for the Year 2017 (Department of Parks and Recreation – Golf Course Management Fees and HVAC System Upgrade and Repairs). Councilman Biddle moved to place the ordinance on second reading. Councilman Hearson seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed third and final reading with a unanimous vote.

**Ordinances & Petitions**

The first item is an an Ordinance Changing the Zoning Classification for Real Estate Located Adjacent to 200 South, Parcel No. 54-10-10-400-014.000-025. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Hearson seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Molin, Councilman Biddle, Councilman Guard, Mayor Barton, Brand Allen (Planning Dept.), John Fry (County Commissioner), John Brock (land owner), John Hedrick (Farmer) and Walt Nelson (Farmer) offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

The second item presented was the Second reading of a request to rezone the property known as 1500 Delegates Row from B-3, business to R-3, residential. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on second reading. Councilman Warren seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

Traffic, Parking & Safety

The first item presented was the second reading of an Ordinance prohibiting parking on the east side of Wallace Drive between Main Street and Pike Street in Crawfordsville, Indiana. Councilman Molin moved to place the ordinance on second reading. Councilman Hearson seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on third and final reading and so adopt. Councilman Reidy seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Guard and Mayor Barton offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed third and final reading with a unanimous vote.
