Board of Public Works & Safety Meeting

Wednesday, November 15, 2017

MINUTES

The Board met on Wednesday, November 8, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. in the Crawfordsville Common Council Chambers with Mayor Barton, Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Deputy Clerk Treasure – Amy Cating, and City Attorney – Kent Minnette present. Also present were Scott Hesler - Street Department, Mike Norman- Police Department, Jim Fulwider - Fire Department, Phil Goode- CEL&P, Megan Huckstep- Planning Department, Larry Kadinger- Waste Water Department, Renee Pirtle – Mayor’s Assistant, Barry Lewis - Code Enforcement, and Bob Cox-The Journal Review.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from November 1, 2017. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve the claims from the week of November 6, 2017. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

New Business

Josh Miller, Backstep Brewing Company, came before the board with a sidewalk closure request. They will be digging a hole no bigger than 4’ by 4’ to better access a potential collapsed pipe. The sidewalk is on Market Street and will need to be closed no more than two days beginning November 12th and ending November 13th. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed the 2018 Wastewater Budget. Larry Kadinger, Wastewater Department, said there are increases to the budget due to the bond payments with the upgrades at the Wastewater Treatment Plant and the combined storm/sewer project. Discussion arose. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members received one bid for the fence at Fire Station #2. The bid was from Lowe’s Custom Fencing – Ladoga, in the amount of \$5,940.00. Mayor Barton moved to take the bid under advisement for one week. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a change order request for services at 1201 E. Elmore Street. The change order is for Keystone Services to do additional work at 1201 E. Elmore Street, and is not to exceed \$10,515.00. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Scott Hesler, Street Commission, requested the board declare as surplus on two old dump trucks and one old salt spreader box. He would like to scrap the salt spreader box and one of the dump trucks. The second dump truck could potentially go to auction and if not it would be scrap also. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Miscellaneous

Mike Norman, Police Chief, would like to request three reserved parking spaces on behalf of the F.O.P. Food Basket Drive. The request would be for three spaces on Spring Street on the east end beginning November 16th thru November 18th. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.


With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
