

# Crawfordsville Common Council Meeting

Monday, November 13, 2017

## Minutes

The Crawfordsville Common Council met in regular session on Monday, November 13, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd, City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman – Charlie Warren, Councilman – Dan Guard, Councilwoman Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Andy Biddle and Councilman –Mike Reidy.

Councilwoman Lowe led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Biddle led the prayer.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. All Council members were present.

Councilman Guard moved to approve the minutes from the October 16<sup>th</sup> meeting. Councilman Warren seconded. Motion passed.

Councilman Biddle moved to acknowledge receipt of the monthly financials. Councilman Reidy seconded. Motion passed.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. Councilman Biddle and Councilman Guard each had one item.

## Fiscal Affairs

The first item presented was the first reading of an Ordinance to establish fund 249 LIT Public Safety. Councilman Biddle moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Warren seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Reidy, Councilman Biddle, Clerk-Treasurer Gadd and Mayor Barton offered comments. Hearing no further comments, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

## Ordinances & Petitions

The first item presented was the first reading of an Ordinance establishing threshold for Real Estate Disposal. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilwoman Lowe

seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

The second item presented was the first reading of an Ordinance establishing Permit Procedures for Wireless Facilities. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Warren seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Biddle and Mayor Barton offered comments. Hearing no further comments, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

**Traffic, Parking & Safety**

The first item presented was the first reading of an Ordinance Designating Portions of the Purple Heart Parkway a No-Truck Route and Establishing Speed Limit. Councilwoman Lowe moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Warren seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

The second item presented was the first reading of an Ordinance Vacating an Alley - North-South alley directly East of 1003 E Pike Street. Councilwoman Lowe moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Guard seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Reidy, Councilwoman Lowe, Brandy Allen (Planning Dept), Greg Morrison (Realtor) and Mayor Barton offered comments. Hearing no further comments, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Biddle also welcomed the students and thanked them for coming.


