Board of Public Works & Safety Meeting

Wednesday, December 20, 2017

MINUTES

The Board met on Wednesday, December 13, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. in the Crawfordsville Common Council Chambers with Mayor Barton, Erin Corbin, Clerk Treasurer – Terri Gadd, and City Attorney – Kent Minnette present. Also present were Mark Cox - Street Department, Jim Sessions- Police Department, Scott Busenbark - Fire Department, Robert Stephens– CEL&P, Brandy Allen - Planning Department, Fawn Johnson – Park & Rec, Mike McKinney– Waste Water Department, Angie Light – Mayor’s Assistant, Barry Lewis, Code Enforcement, Dale Petrie, Director of Operations and Bob Cox-The Journal Review.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from December 6, 2017. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the claims from the week of December 11, 2017. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

Board members discussed a bid received from Environmental Demolition Group, LLC. in the amount of \$129,400.00 for demolition services at 101 W. Main Street. The bid was an oversight, Clerk Treasurer, Terri Gadd, made an affidavit for the bid file and the file was opened in the present of witnesses. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a bid from Hard Hats & Hammers for demolition services at the PNC building for \$45,000.00. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

New Business

Board members discussed the request from Robert Stephens, CEL&P, to add 3-4 streetlights along the south side of Purple Heart Pkwy to light up the portion within the City limits. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed the request from Robert Stephens, CEL&P, to add a streetlight in front of 2011 Traction Road. Robert stated that it does fall in the range to add another streetlight. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed the request from Barry Lewis, Code Enforcement Officer, for trash to be removed from the property at 609 Wilson. Barry Lewis said that the renters contacted him because the trash belongs to the owners of the house, Gordon and Jacob Dagley. Mayor Barton asked if the property was registered and if it had a homestead exemption. Barry stated he would check to see if it was registered and that there is no homestead exemption. He would give them till December 18, 2017 to get it

cleaned up, if not the Street Department will. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.


Miscellaneous
