

Crawfordsville Common Council Meeting Minutes

March 12, 2018

The Crawfordsville Common Council met in special session on Monday, March 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd, City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman – Stan Hamilton, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Andy Biddle, Councilman – Jeff Lucas, Councilman – Mike Reidy, Councilman – Dan Guard, and Councilman – Charlie Warren.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. All Council members were present.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. Councilman Biddle had one item to add to the agenda.

Committee of the Whole

Councilman Reidy moved to adjourn the Common Council and convene the Committee of the whole.

The resolution passed with a unanimous vote.

(Resolution #5 - 2018)

The sixth item presented is the first reading of an Ordinance Making an Additional Appropriation for the Year 2018 (Department of Parks and Recreation - Golf Course Equipment). Councilman Biddle moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Warren seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Biddle offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.


