

Crawfordsville Common Council Meeting

Monday, February 12, 2018

Minutes

The Crawfordsville Common Council met in special session on Monday, February 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer Terri Gadd, City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman – Stan Hamilton, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Andy Biddle, Councilman – Jeff Lucas, Councilman – Mike Reidy, and Councilman – Dan Guard. Councilman Charlie Warren was not present.

Also present were: Mike Norman – Police Department, Scott Hesler – Street Department, Dale Taylor – Wastewater Department, Scott Busenbark – Fire Department, Phil Goode – CEL&P, Brandy Allen – Planning Department, Fawn Johnson – Park & Recreation.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. All Council members were present except Councilman Warren.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. No additions were requested.

Chairman Barton opened the floor for an appointment for Fire Commissioner for 2018 serving a four year term. Councilman Biddle nominated Aaron Morgan for the position. The roll was called for the vote on the nomination of Aaron Morgan. The nomination carried with a unanimous vote.

Ordinance & Petitions

The first item presented is the first reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 114: Peddler, Solicitors, and Itinerant Merchants of the Crawfordsville City Code. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Biddle seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Guard and Chairman Barton offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

(First Reading)

The second item presented is the first reading of an Ordinance Amending City Code Chapter 94: Human Rights. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on first reading. Councilman Reidy seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Councilman Biddle, Councilman Lucas, Chairman Barton and Kent Minnette offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

The third item presented is the second reading of an Ordinance Amending the Crawfordsville City Code § 97.09 Prohibited Conduct in Parks – Municipal Golf Course. Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on second reading. Councilwoman Lowe seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Guard moved to place the ordinance on third and final reading and so adopt. Councilwoman Lowe seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed third and final reading with a unanimous vote.

Traffic, Parking & Safety



Councilman Biddle, Councilman Lucas, Chairman Barton, Councilman Reidy and Councilwoman Lowe offered comments. Hearing no further, the roll was called for the vote.
