The Board met on Wednesday, July 25, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in the Crawfordsville Common Council Chambers with Mayor Barton, Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht and City Attorney – Kent Minnette present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from July 18, 2018. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Four Seasons Local Market is requesting to place a grill in the alley and a canopy between 216/218 E. Main Street on August 3rd in conjunction with the First Friday Events. They would like to request the alley be closed on August 3rd 5-8:30 pm. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed the City’s new Flood Response Plan. Brandy Allen, Planning Director, said the City received a grant to put together a plan and lays out a map of the affected areas. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Hay-Bush Mechanical to replace an air conditioning condenser unit at the PNC drive thru building. The agreement is in the amount of \$2,857.20. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Department Heads


Chief Norman, Police Department, invited everyone to stay after the Board of Works and Public Safety meeting for the swearing in of three new officers.

Scott Hesler, Street Commissioner, said they are continuing to pave and should wrap up in the next week.


Adjournment
