## Board of Public Works & Safety Meeting

### MINUTES

The Board met on Wednesday, August 8, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in the Crawfordsville Common Council Chambers with Mayor Barton, Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht and City Attorney – Kent Minnette present. Board members discussed a contract addition with Haley’s Lock, Safe & Key to install ADA compliant door opening system to Fusion 54. Dale Petrie, Director of Operations, stated the building could be accessible 24/7 and currently just the bank entrance is ADA compliant. The contract is in the amount of \$13,246.00. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

### Department Heads


Larry Kadinger, Wastewater, thanked Rich Mesaros with American Water for his help downtown.

Adjournment


With there being no further business, Erin Corbin moved to adjourn. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
