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### *MINUTES*

The Board met on Wednesday, August 15, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in the Crawfordsville Common Council Chambers with Mayor Barton, Susan Albrecht and City Attorney – Kent Minnette present. The Paper of Montgomery County is request to use the parking spaces on the north side of Main Street east of Washington from 7:00 am – 12:00 pm on October 30<sup>th</sup> for the Indiana Blood Drive bus. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Price Excavating in regards to the driveway extension in the Crawfordsville Commerce Park. The agreement is in the amount of \$26,972.00. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Form It Up Concrete in regards to constructing a concrete pad outside the Street Department’s garage bay door. The agreement is in the amount of \$1,584.00. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.


Department Heads


Scott Hesler, Street Commissioner, informed everyone that Rod Jenkins passes away. He was a City employee for 37 years.
