HEALTH DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES TWO DEATHS, SEVEN NEW CASES

CRAWFORDSVILLE, Ind. — The Montgomery County Health Department (MCHD) announced today seven new confirmed cases of COVID-19, bringing the total lab-confirmed cases to 180 since the first case was recorded in March. Two deaths related to COVID-19 were reported to the MCHD. There have been 13 overall deaths.

Contact investigations by the Indiana State Department of Health are underway in connection with the new cases.

Below is an updated breakdown of COVID-19 cases connected to residents of long-term care facilities in Montgomery County.
