## **HEALTH DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES TWO NEW CASES, PROVIDES UPDATED BREAKDOWN FOR LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES**

CRAWFORDSVILLE, Ind. — The Montgomery County Health Department (MCHD) announced today two new confirmed cases of COVID-19, bringing the total lab-confirmed cases to 233 since the first case was recorded in March.

Contact investigations by the Indiana State Department of Health are underway in connection with the new cases.
