The Board met virtually on Wednesday, January 13, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from January 6, 2021. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Linn Ringis, Montgomery County Leadership Academy, to use the first two parking spaces on the south side of Main Street in front of Fusion 54. Board members discussed an agreement between the City and the Montgomery County Animal Welfare League. This is a renewal of the annual agreement in the amount of \$121,000. Mayor Barton said there was added language into the agreement that complies with the open door law. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an interlocal governmental agreement between the City and County for planning, zoning and building jurisdiction for annexations. Brandy Allen said this is to oversee land use. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Dave Dolph to abate the burn ordinance to allow him to burn brush and clear land at a property that is located on Corda Blvd, north of Autumn Woods apartments. Due to residents at the apartment complex and concerns of food being processed at Pace Dairy, Mayor Barton made a motion to deny the request. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.
