MINUTES

The Board met in person on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Tyler Nichols - City Attorney present. Also present were Terri Gadd - Clerk Treasurer, Aaron Mattingly - Police Department, Scott Busenbark - Fire Department, Fawn Johnson - Park & Rec, Brandy Allen - Planning Department, Phil Goode - CELP&P, Larry Kadinger - Wastewater, Chris Moore - Street Department and Renee Pirtle - Mayor's Assistant.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from April 28, 2021. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve the claims from May 3, 2021. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request to surplus city owned property from the Crawfordsville Fire Department. Chief Busenbark said they have two vehicles, 2006 Pontiac Grand Prix (VIN # 1B3ES46C620598620) and 2002 Dodge Neon SE (VIN# 1B3ES46C620598620) both valued at \$500 each. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a resolution reviewing and completing the City of Crawfordsville Covid-19 pandemic small business relief program. There were 42 businesses that received money through the relief program equaling \$250,200 total. Susan Albrecht moved to approve resolution #3. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Daria Horticulture and Environmental (DHE) for wetland and stream delineation services. This is for the commerce park to see what area can and can't be developed. The agreement is in the amount of \$3,800. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a subdivision improvement agreement for Diamond Ridge Subdivision Phase 1 & 2. Chris Moore, Street Department, said everything met the requirements. Brandy Allen, Planning Director, noted the money refunded is the deposit they held until the project was completed and approved (Phase 1 - \$74,475 and Phase 2 - \$62,000). Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.



Adjournment


With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
