Mary Sheidler requested to use 2 parking spaces at 107 E. Main Street on April 24th beginning at 8:30 am for a moving truck. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Darin Glover requested to block the sidewalk on E. Main Street for concrete work on the Alley Project beginning April 24 - May 5 and 2 parking spaces east of the alley thru July. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Darin Glover requested to close the sidewalks at Francis Wooden Park for reconstruction through August, effective immediately, Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.




With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
